

Call for applications

The Joint Publications Committee representing the Political Communication divisions of the International Communication Association and American Political Science Association seeks applications for two critical positions: (1) webmaster and editor of *Political Communication Report* (PCR) and (2) social-media officer.

The webmaster and editor of *PCR* is responsible for:

- Ensuring that the divisions' [website](#) remains up to date and serves the divisions effectively.
- Conceptualizing, securing submissions for, and editing the divisions' biannual online publication, *Political Communication Report* (*PCR*). Each issue revolves around a specific theme and comprises a combination of submissions and interviews. More information and recent issues can be found [here](#).

The social-media officer's responsibilities include:

- Updating the divisions' social-media accounts and ensuring the platforms continue to serve the community.
- Circulating activities and opportunities of interest to the community.
- Promoting the divisions' activities and panels during the APSA and ICA annual meetings.
- Developing ways for intellectually and geographically diverse political-communication scholars to engage meaningfully with our community.

Both positions are accompanied by a modest stipend and will run from 15 February 2025 to 31 December 2027, with the opportunity to be extended up to another two calendar years. The appointed individuals will keep in close contact with the divisional leadership and present reports at the Political Communication business meetings at ICA and APSA.

Interested individuals should submit to Patricia Moy (U of Washington): (1) a cover letter that articulates their plans and goals for the position for which they are applying; (2) their CV; and (3) the names of three references.
